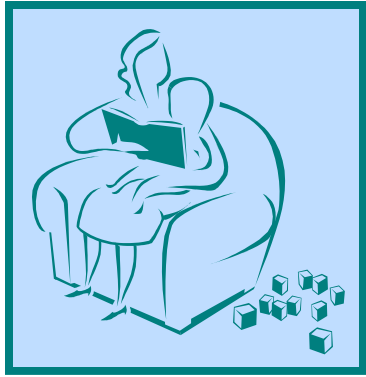
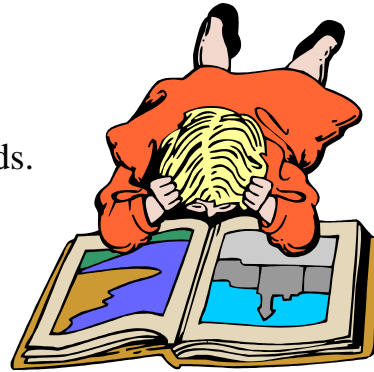


Reading ↔ Success
