## DOCUMENTING SOURCES (MLA 8th)

List your sources in alphabetical order (by author or title, whichever comes first).

## **Bibliography—Websites & Youtube videos.**

In general, include the same elements, in the same order as you would for a reference for a printed media source and add as much electronic retrieval information as needed for others to locate the source. The citation should include:

**Author(s):** Booth, Wayne C., and Broer, Lawrence [Use author's full first name. If no author is named, place the title of the document in the author position]

**Title of the work:** The title should be written in a normal type

**Title of the overall website:** Italicized if distinct from the title of the work otherwise not italicized.

**Date of publication:** 27 Sept. 2009. [If no date, use: (n.d.).]

**Date when you accessed the web page:** Date you accessed (viewed) the page preceded by the word Accessed. Use the appropriate abbreviation for months. End citation with a period

In case it is from youtube: Use uploaded by and write the name of the creator.
